Please refer to syllabus prior to using the official online "entry" portal. The adjudicator will only hear competitors on the day and time specified in the Feis Programme. Competitors may enter in own age group only. Age shall be reckoned as on the **1st January 2025**.

Age: In all competitions no competitor may enter in more than one age group.

Example one: 8-10 years means, aged 8 or 9 on 1st January 2025.

Example two: 12-15 years means aged 12, 13 or 14 years on the 1st January 2025

Official Accompanist: An official accompanist will be provided. **If required copies of music must be sent by post to Ann O'Hara, Drumcliffe, Co. Sligo. (Emailed Copies will NOT BE ACCEPTED)** In Choral and Ensemble competitions competitors may provide their own accompanist.

Own Choice Music: Competitors must bring a copy to the adjudicator or marks can be deducted. All music must be clearly marked with the name of the competitor and class for which it is intended. Music must be claimed at the end of each session. The Committee will not be responsible for lost music.
